This certification is a culmination of Aurora's efforts to embed sustainable practices across all areas of its business. The company was assessed on its impact across five key areas: governance, workers, community, environment, and customers. Part of this is its portfolio of sustainability programs, working to protect 'Planet' and 'People' through initiatives such as its 100% Climate Neutral status, emissions reduction strategies, conservation and climate change education, support of the UN's Sustainable Development Goals and more.

"We are exceedingly proud to join the B Corp community following a rigorous, but rewarding process," commented Aurora Expeditions' CEO, Michael Heath.

This certification also follows the release of the company's inaugural <u>Impact Report</u> in mid-2023.
